TREATMENT FOR BED BUGS

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Make and post a list of all places you are seeing bed bugs.
2. Do ALL your cleaning before, not after, the treatment.
 3. Everything, except appliances and furniture, is to be off all floors, including closets.
 4. There can NOT be any items on or under any stuffed furniture or beds.
 5. Remove all trash and garbage from the apartment. Everything that you do not use everyday must be removed from and kept out of the apartment. Remove all clutter.
 6. All torn mattresses and furniture are to be disposed of (don't use again).
 7. Strip all bedding from the beds. Stand up the mattress & box springs against the wall.
 8. Cover or put away all food. Cover all food processing surfaces and utensils.
 9. The bedding you are currently using needs to be washed and dried in a dryer.
 10. All windows must be closed. All fans off. Cover tissue paper, contact lens cleaner, cosmetics, tooth brushes, hair brushes, etc.
 11. Remove from the premises all valuables (money, jewelry, etc.).
 12. If you are not going to be home, make arrangements so that the exterminator can get into your apartment.
 13. No one and all pets are not to be in the premises for at least **1 hour** after the treatment. Fish tanks are to sealed off with plastic with the air turned off.
 14. Right after the treatment has dried, all mattresses and box springs are to be put into bed bug proof plastic mattress bags.
 15. All beds should be kept at least **1 foot** from all walls and all bedding should not touch the floor.
 16. Do not wash the floors nor shampoo rugs, except for spot cleaning, for at least two (2) months.

NOTICE: THERE IS A \$45.00 ADDITIONAL RENTAL CHARGE IF YOUR APARTMENT IS NOT READY IN TIME FOR THE ABOVE WORK AND/OR YOU MAY BE EVICTED.

NOTE: You may see bed bugs after the treatment.

NOTE: After four weeks, if you see any bed bugs make arrangements to have your dwelling retreated in a week.
